Frequently Asked Questions FAQ

1. Who can participate with OCCRRA as their sponsor?

Certified Family Child Care Providers who have a continuous license granted by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) or have alternate approval according to the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) guidelines and maintain and provide current documentation to support certification or alternate approval.

2. What is the cost to participate in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)?

There is no cost for participating providers.

3. How are reimbursement claims filed?

Reimbursement claims are filed electronically. OCCRRA will provide the software and training necessary to file the claims.

4. How will I receive the reimbursement?

Reimbursements are issued by direct deposit into your bank account. No need to pick up or cash a check.

5. Can I submit claims for meals served to my own children?

Providers may claim for their own children only in the provider is income eligible and has an approved Income Eligibility Application (IEA) on file. Own children's meals can only be reimbursed when nonresidential children are in care eating the same meal at the same time.

6. How many meals can be claimed for each enrolled child per day?

A maximum of two meals and one snack or two snacks and one meal can be claimed for each enrolled child each day.

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
