## OCCRRA Workforce Development Online CDA Training Scholarship Eligibility and Application

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide 120 hours of online training to meet the initial CDA training requirements.

You may be eligible for assistance with online CDA training if you are a:

- Type B Family Child Care Provider, Type A Family Child Care Provider, or teacher, assistant teacher, director, or owner employed in an ODJFS licensed early care and learning program.
- Have worked at one of the programs listed above within the last 12 months.

Scholarship benefits include:

- 120 hours of training from the online training provider
- Internet Stipend: \$100 upon completion of the introductory course
- Compensation: \$250 upon completion of the 120 hours of training
